Terms and Conditions for running, triathlon, cycling and swimming events

Should you withdraw from the event the following rules shall apply:

1. If under the rules of the event you are entitled to receive a refund of your entry fee or part thereof none or only the outstanding balance will be paid to you by RCSCF and then only if the sum you have raised shall be equal to or greater than your minimum pledge.
2. If at the time of your withdrawal for whatever reason whether before or during the event all sponsorship money raised will be treated as donations to RCSCF. All terms relating to the pledge for that event will be honoured by RCSCF.

General terms and conditions relating to your participation in the event as a Rotary Charity Fundraiser:

1. You commit to raising at least the amount of the pledge you have selected and signed up for. If you are unable to meet the amount of the pledge you may choose to make up the balance yourself or you may, under our terms for the particular event, lose your entry place.
2. In Charity Partner events where you have taken a guaranteed place RCSCF reserves the right, should you not raise amount of the pledge after due notice, to inform the organisers that you are no longer a Rotary Charity Fundraiser with the result that your place in the event may be withdrawn.
3. All funds raised shall be deemed to be donations to RCSCF and are non-refundable.
4. All funds raised through the event shall be made payable to RCSCF.
5. You agree to raise all your funds using legal methods and complying with the advice given in the Fundraising Pack.
6. You confirm that you have undertaken to comply with the terms and conditions of the event you are participating in.
7. You agree to RCSCF storing the information that you provided on their database. See our privacy policy for details.
8. You give RCSCF permission to use any photographs and/or videos taken of you at your chosen event to promote RCSCF to the wider public.
9. You confirm that to the best of your knowledge your general state of health and fitness is good and you take full responsibility for any training needed to ensure you are able to successfully take part in the event you have selected.
10. You confirm that you take part in the event you have chosen at your own risk.

Rotary event waiver, release and indemnification:

In consideration of the acceptance of my entry to the event as a Rotary Charity Fundraiser:

For myself, my executors, administrators, heirs, next of kin, successors and assigns, I HEREBY:

- a. Waive and release any and all claims that I may have against Rotary International, Rotary Great Britain and Ireland, Rotary Districts, Clubs, Rotarians or any volunteers or others (“the releasees”) from any or claims for damage caused by the negligence of any of them, arising out of my participation in the event and its related activities, together with any costs including lawyers’ fees that may be incurred as a result of any such claim whether valid or not.
- b. Indemnify and hold harmless the releasees and each of them against any such claim that may be made against them including any lawyers’ fees with respect thereto.
